



THREE ANGELS HONOR REQUIREMENTS (ANSWER KEY)

The purpose of this honor is to ground Pathfinders in the knowledge of the three angels' messages so they will understand and apply Revelation 14: 6-12 to their own lives.

1. Memorize Revelation 14:6. When given the name of each of the 13 world divisions of the Seventh-day Adventist Church, name one country where the gospel is being shared in each division.
 - a. **Then I saw another angel flying in midair, and he had the eternal gospel to proclaim to those who live on the earth—to every nation, tribe, language and people. NIV**

2. What four things about Jesus are revealed in the three angels' messages?

PP Slide 16

The messages reveal Jesus':

- Love
- Grace
- Forgiveness
- Power

3. What does the first angel mean by "fear God?" *PP Slide 17*

To show Him reverence and respect

4. What three things does the first angel tell us to do? *PP Slide 17*

- Fear God
- Give glory to Him
- Worship your Creator

5. Watch the video on the *Three Angels for Kids* channel, "[Great Disappointment or Great Revelation?](#)" What did the early believers think was going to happen in 1844? What did they discover? (Alternative: Explain to students what happened with the early believers in 1844. Reference: *The Great Controversy*, Chapter 22)

- The early believers thought Jesus was coming in 1844.**
- They discovered Jesus was entering the Most Holy Place. They rejoiced, knowing that Jesus was interceding for them in the judgment.**

6. First Angel: Provide three reasons to give God glory for the judgment.

- Christ makes our record clean. His perfect sacrifice covers all of our sins. When we accept Jesus we do not have to be afraid of the judgment.**
- God is always fair. The judgment will put an end to everything that is unfair here on earth.**
- Jesus is coming soon. The judgment brings us closer to the second coming of Christ.**

7. What is a symbol? Give some examples.
A symbol is a thing that represents something else. For example, a heart stands for love. A flag stands for loyalty to your country.

8. Second Angel: What does the symbol of Babylon represent in the second angel's message?

Babylon represents confused man-made worship that turns away from the clear teachings of the Bible.

9. Second Angel: Watch the [animation of King Nebuchadnezzar's dream](#) to further understand the meaning of the symbol of Babylon in Revelation. (Alternative: Read Daniel 2 and compare the Old Testament story to Revelation 14.)

Explain to someone how the king's dream in Daniel 2 can help us understand Revelation 14:8, the second angel's message. **King Nebuchadnezzar took some of the truth (the head of gold) and mixed it with error (by making the entire image into gold.) When Babylon falls, the same thing will happen. Religious and political leaders will take some of the truth in the Bible and mix it with error.**

10. Third Angel: What does the third angel warn against?
The third angel warns us not to be deceived.

11. Third Angel: What is meant by the symbol of the mark in the forehead and in the hand?

The mark in the head represents thinking apart from God's law; the mark in the hand represents acting apart from God's law.

12. Third Angel: What will be the final test of loyalty to our Creator? *PP Slide 19*
The final test of loyalty to our Creator will be the seventh day Sabbath.

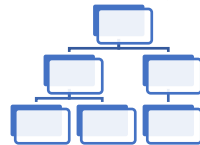
13. View the video "[How Should You Respond?](#)" What should our attitude be towards those who do not fully understand Bible truths at this time? (Alternative: Discuss the following answer with Pathfinders.)

We are not here to judge anyone. We should lovingly accept all people—including those who do not share our beliefs. When the opportunity is appropriate, we can share the Bible truths.

14. Revelation 14:8 refers to a time when you may be forced to go against your beliefs and conscience. Watch the video, "[What if Someone Asks You to Do Something Wrong?](#)" (Alternative: Ask Pathfinders to talk about what they would do if someone tried to get them to do something wrong.)
- Tell someone about an experience when you or someone else had to make a difficult decision regarding your beliefs.
 - Provide 3 examples in the Bible of characters who stood up for their beliefs during difficult circumstances.

15. Summarize the three angels' messages with a graphic organizer. You may use the graphic organizer provided or create your own. When you are finished, explain to your counselor, unit or club. (Graphic Organizer and Answer Key on website.)

(Alternative: Show students an example of a graphic organizer and ask them to create their own summary of the main facts of each message.)



16. Watch the [Three Angels' song](#) and the [Three Angels Action Claps](#). Then work together as a team to come up with your own song or creative way to communicate the three angels' messages. When you are finished, perform for a group.

17. Create and display a stained-glass scene of the three angels flying in the sky using one of the following options:
- Faux Stained Glass with Acrylic Paint and Glue. (Template and directions on *Three Angels for Kids* website)
 - Adapt option "a" above. Substitute colored tissue paper for painting.
 - Stained Glass with Fine Markers (Template and directions follow "Faux Stained Glass" directions on the same document.)
 - Alternative: Select another art project showing the three angels. Complete project and display work.

Recommendations

1. For larger clubs, create small groups. Pathfinders rotate between groups.
 - a. *The gospel being shared by the world SDA church*: Print the “flash cards.” Cut out and glue to large index cards (5 x 8). On the alternate side, write the name of the division. Have Pathfinders practice naming one country from each division with the flash cards.
 - b. *Action claps or song*. Practice until Pathfinders can do on their own.
 - c. *Stained glass*. Begin with faux lead. Let dry until next meeting.
 - d. *Graphic Organizer*. Work with students to fill out graphic organizer.
2. Use the Pathfinder Checklist to track students as they master each of the 17 requirements. Provide opportunities for Pathfinders to answer questions orally or in writing to allow for student differences.
3. Play jeopardy with the following questions:
 1. The worldwide Seventh-day Adventist Church shares the gospel in this division that includes such countries as Argentina and Bolivia. (What is the South American Division?)
 2. This verse tells us that before Jesus comes, the gospel will be shared with every nation, tribe, tongue and people. (What is Revelation 14:6?)
 3. The three angels’ messages share the good news about Jesus’ love, grace, power and this. (What is forgiveness?)
 4. This word in the first angel’s message means to show God reverence and respect. (What is fear?)
 5. The first angel tells us to do these three things. (What is fear God, give Him glory, worship the Creator?)
 6. The early believers thought Jesus was coming in 1844, but He actually entered this new phase of his ministry for us in that year. (What is the judgment hour?)
 7. These three reasons are powerful reminders of why we worship God because of the judgment hour. (What are: Jesus makes our record clean, God is always fair, the judgment brings us closer to the second coming of Jesus.)
 8. A heart, a flag, and Babylon are examples of this. (What is a symbol?)

9. This message contains a symbol that stands for confused man-made worship that turns away from the clear teachings of the Bible. (What is the second angel's message?)
 10. This old Testament king did something that helps us understand the meaning of the symbol of Babylon falling. (Who is Nebuchadnezzar?)
 11. This angel warns us not to be deceived. (What is the third angel?)
 12. Marks in these two places stand for thinking and acting apart from God's commandments. (What is the head and the hand)
 13. God's people at the end of time will have these two traits. (What is patience and faith in Jesus?)
 14. This will be the final test of loyalty to God. (What is the Sabbath?)
 15. After the events in the three angels' messages take place, this will happen. (What is the second coming of Jesus?)
4. Create a "Kahoot" to review with the Pathfinders.
