



**THREE ANGELS HONOR
REQUIREMENTS (ANSWER KEY)
(REVISED with FEEDBACK FROM SURVEYS)**

The purpose of this honor is to ground Pathfinders in the knowledge of the three angels' messages so they will understand and apply Revelation 14: 6-12 to their own lives.

1. Memorize Revelation 14:6. Name three of the divisions of the Seventh-day Adventist Church sharing the gospel around the world and point to a country on the map or globe where their work is being done.
2. What four things about Jesus are revealed in the three angels' messages?
3. What does the first angel mean by "fear God?"
4. What three things does the first angel tell us to do?
5. Watch the video on the *Three Angels for Kids* channel, "[Great Disappointment or Great Revelation?](#)" What did the early believers think was going to happen in 1844? What did they discover?
6. First Angel: Provide three reasons to give God glory for the judgment.
7. What is a symbol? Give some examples.
8. Second Angel: What does the symbol of Babylon represent in the second angel's message?
9. Second Angel: Watch the [animation of King Nebuchadnezzar's dream](#) to further understand the meaning of the symbol of Babylon in Revelation.
 - a. Explain to someone how the king's dream in Daniel 2 can help us understand Revelation 14:8, the second angel's message?
 - b. Memorize Daniel 2: 20, 21

10. Third Angel: What does the third angel warn against?
11. Third Angel: What is meant by the symbol of the mark in the forehead and in the hand?
12. Third Angel: What will be the final test of loyalty to our Creator?
13. View the video "[How Should You Respond?](#)" What should our attitude be towards those who do not fully understand Bible truths at this time?
14. Revelation 14:8 refers to a time when you may be forced to go against your beliefs and conscience. Watch the video, "[What if Someone Asks You to Do Something Wrong?](#)"
 - a. Tell someone about an experience when you or someone else had to make a difficult decision regarding your beliefs.
 - b. Provide 3 examples in the Bible of characters who stood up for their beliefs during difficult circumstances.
15. Summarize the three angels' messages with a graphic organizer. You may use the graphic organizer provided or create your own. When you are finished, explain to your counselor, unit or club.
16. Perform one of the following for a group:
 - a. Sing and sign the [Three Angels' song](#) (Using American Sign Language)
 - b. [Three Angels Action Claps](#)
 - c. Create your own song or claps
17. Create and display a stained-glass scene of the three angels flying in the sky using one of the following options:
 - a. Faux Stained Glass with Acrylic Paint and Glue
 - b. Stained Glass with Fine Markers
 - c. Alternative: Select another art project showing the three angels. Complete project and display work
